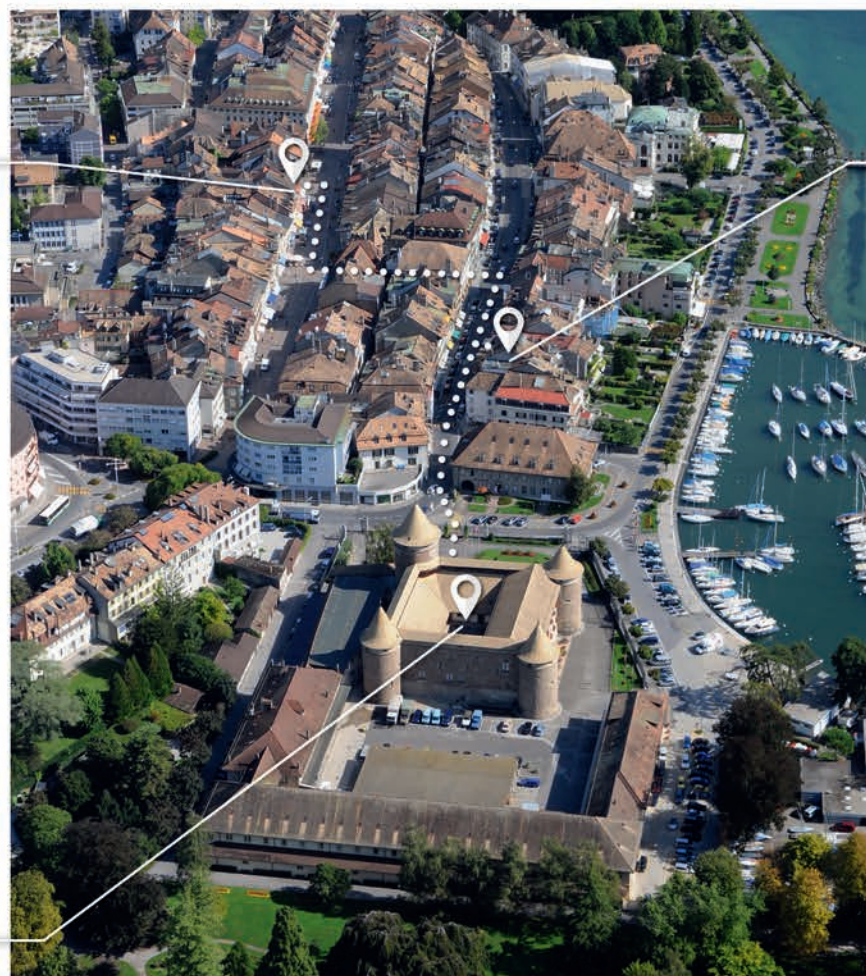


## An exhibition presented in three exceptional venues
